- 10. Amend REG103.3 to allow the use of symbols when naming a horse. **
- 11. Amend REG104.1 to allow horses that are registered with APHA and have majority Quarter Horse lineage to be eligible for registration using allowances similar to Thoroughbred/Quarter Horse crosses. **
- 12. Amend REG104.4 and REG105.5, for horses being registered based on an international studbook, to include a statement that if the unregistered lineage traces to Appendix/Appendix or Appendix/Thoroughbred cross, it is ineligible for registration. **
- 13. Amend REG103.4.3, REG103.4.4 and REG118.4 to include a statement that a horse name cannot be changed if it has a record of performance in the QData database.**
- 14. Remove REG118.5 which would allow horses with a breeding record to be eligible for a name change**.
- 15. Amend REG102.8.5 and REG108.3 to allow horses to bypass DNA requirements for registration if they are deemed outstanding breeding stock by the Executive Committee as outlined REG107 for previously cancelled horses.**
- 16. Amend REG102.8 to require all horses registered with AQHA to be DNA typed and parentage verified.**

- 17. Add REG114.18 to recognize the color Buckskin Roan. **
- 18. Add REG114.19 to recognize the color Palomino Roan. **
- 19. Amend REG109 to include myosin heavy chain myopathy (MYHM formerly known as IMM) as a genetic defect and undesirable trait.**
- 20. Amend REG109 to add a statement to registration certificates of foals descending from a horse who is a carrier that AQHA recommends testing to confirm presence or absence of the mutation. **
- 21. Add MYHM to the genetic health panel. **
- 22. Allow MYHM to be an optional addition to any disease panel testing for the additional applicable cost. **
- 23. Amend REG108.5 to allow parentage-verified foals to receive the designation "N/N" for any diseases in which both parents are also "N/N." **
- 24. Amend REG108 to begin with the following statement: AQHA is the sole owner of any and all DNA material and results processed by AQHA's official laboratory pursuant to AQHA's registration rules and/or AQHA request.
- 25. Remove "postmarked or" from rule REG110.1 so the deadline for stallion breeding reports becomes consistent with all other work submitted to AQHA.
- 26. Modify REG113.2 to allow foals to be registered without a breeder's certificate when there are extenuating circumstances.
- 27. Amend REG124.4 to remove the seller's responsibility to deliver the transfer report and certificate of registration to AQHA.
- 28. Amend REG108.4 and REG108.5 to change the name of the disease panel test to health panel test.**
