FEI 2011 EUROPEAN CHAMPIONSHIP REINING

QUALIFICATION CRITERIA CH-EU-R Senior and J/YR Neustadt (AUT) 24-29.07.2011

Seniors

Qualification period: Start: 1 January 2010 End: nominated date of entries

Minimum qualification criteria: To be eligible to compete either as a member of a team or as an individual at the 2011 FEI European Reining Championships, an athlete must achieve a minimum average score of **68** at two different CRIs during the qualification period.

Teams: A NF wishing to send Teams to the 2011 FEI European Reining Championships must have organised at least two CRI events within their country during the qualification period.

Individuals: A NF which does not have the minimum of 3 athletes for the team competition qualified as per above, may still send 1 or 2 individual athletes who have achieved the minimum qualification criteria as stated above.

Young Riders (Art. YR-J-Ch 5 General)

- 1. CRIs and Championships for Young Riders are open to athletes from the beginning of the year in which they reach the age of 16 until the end of the year in which they reach the age of 21.
- 2. The participation of a Young Rider in a Championship in one discipline for Young Riders does not exclude the same athlete on another horse from participating in a Championship for Seniors in another discipline, if he has reached the appropriate age.
- 3. Once an athlete has taken part in a Championship for Young Riders in any discipline, he can no longer go back to a Championship for Juniors in the same discipline.
- 4. Once an athlete has taken part in a Championship for Seniors in a particular discipline, he can no longer go back to a Championship for Young Riders in the same discipline.

Juniors

- 1. CRIs and Championships for Juniors are open to athletes from the beginning of the year in which they reach the age of 14 until the end of the year in which they reach the age of 18.
- 2. A Junior (during his 18th year) who has taken part in a Senior Continental or World Championship - is no longer eligible to compete, neither as a Junior nor as a Young Rider, in any international Reining events for Juniors or Young Riders with the same horse.

Horses must be minimum 6 years of age.

REMINDER

All Riders & Horses participating in any International competition must be registered with the FEI.

See General Regulations, 23rd Edition Art. 113.3:

"Any Athlete and/or any Horse who is not registered with the FEI shall be automatically disqualified".
